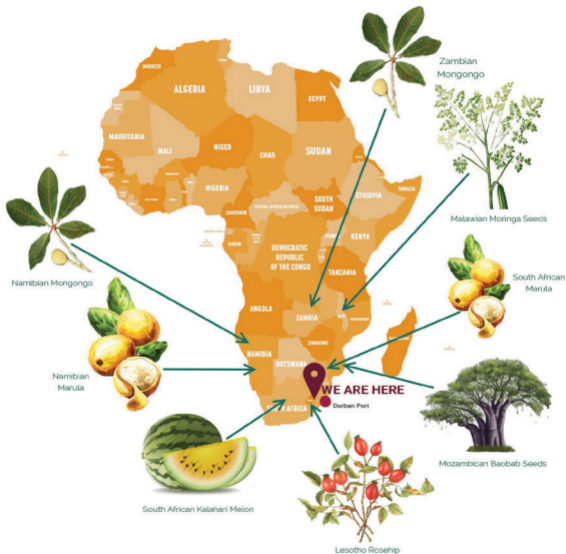

- Baobab oil is significantly hydrating with its occlusive properties (it helps skin to retain moisture) when topically applied to the skin.
- It is also non-irritating and non-comedogenic (it does not clog pores).
- Baobab oil has a unique fatty acid profile with a functional balance of palmitic, linoleic (omega 6), and oleic (omega 9) acids. The combination of oleic and linoleic acids is known to soften the skin and to restore and moisturise the epidermis. These fatty acids regenerate the epithelial tissues, rendering it an excellent oil for cosmetic use.
- The high palmitic acid content helps to stabilise the oil and reduce rancidity, thereby increasing shelf life.
- Baobab oil is rich in phytosterols, predominantly β -sitosterol, an antioxidant shielding against free radical damage.

- However, it is the stability of Kalahari melon oil that makes it truly unique, allowing the oil to withstand heating during formulation and oxidation over time. This is what makes it an incredibly versatile and resilient ingredient for use in formulation.
- The high sterol component preserves the skin barrier.
- Abundant phytosterols contribute to soothing and protection.

ORGANIC MARULA SEED OIL

INCI: *SCLEROCARYA BIRREA* SEED OIL

- Due to its naturally occurring high oleic acid content, marula oil acts as its own carrier oil. It rapidly and deeply penetrates the upper dermal layer, effectively utilising its rich active ingredients to hydrate and fortify the skin.
- Its high level of steric acid allows it to lock in moisture by forming a natural seal over moisturised skin.
- The oil's antioxidants and fatty acids, including omega 9, penetrate the skin and hair and help to stimulate collagen production, which leaves a satin finish to the skin.
- Marula oil is recommended to help soothe sensitive skin and reduce redness and inflammation.
- This oil has a phenolic content of around 3.05 GAE/g and contains the flavonoids gallotannin and procyanidine. Together with minor fatty acids, these flavonoids may be responsible for the mild antibacterial activity of the oil.

- Rich in palmitoleic acid (omega 7) and oleic acid (omega 9), this oil resembles and even mimics human sebum, sealing in moisture, aiding the absorption of other active ingredients, and fighting inflammation.
- Phytosterols in macadamia oil soothe skin and reduce redness, rashes, and itchiness, providing relief for various skin conditions, including eczema and psoriasis.
- Palmitoleic acid and squalene counteract lipid peroxidation, reducing cell damage and maintaining the skin's vitality.
- Macadamia oil's light, non-greasy nature ensures deep hair shaft penetration and nourishment.
